All pre-registered riders are guaranteed to receive the newest designed patriotic Race T-Shirt. Show your colors and have fun spinning The Firecracker Race! **Awards ceremony and free refreshments** will follow the Race. **PLEASE PRE-REGISTER - (Rider Cap of 150 Participants)**

**\*NOTE:** Peloton Formation from Brockway High School until passing Sheetz on Main Street. Follow (**NO RACING**) the Police cruiser to Sheetz, where separation occurs. Brockway Police Depts, Brockway Fire Police, Horton Twp & Falls Creek Fire Police, & Brockway EMT's provide valuable assistance to make this race as safe as possible. Also, a special thank you to all of the volunteers involved who make the Tour de Brockway one of Pa's Premier Road Races!



## 2018 BROCKWAY BICYCLE RACE ROUTE:

The **37<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL TOUR de BROCKWAY** is scheduled for **July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 11:00 AM**. The Race starts and finishes at Brockway High School. All riders should be off the race route by 1:00 PM. A majority of the events planned for Brockway's 4<sup>th</sup> of July celebration will take place on **Wednesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>**. This year's **BICYCLE RACE ROUTE IS 21½ MILES** in length. The **REGISTERED PARTICIPANTS / RIDERS** will be escorted by the Brockway Police Department in a marked patrol car. The rear of the race pack will be supported/ followed by a Brockway Area Ambulance. We are anticipating between 75 and 150 men & women participants/racers in the 2018 Brockway Bicycle Race. **I Race Cap is at-150 Total Riders I**

The **Tour de Brockway** begins at Brockway High School on NORTH STREET in Brockway. The Race continues on SR#1010 to Main Street in Brockway which is SR#0028. This is a LEFT TURN onto MAIN STREET. Follow MAIN STREET to SR#219 NORTH. Continue on SR#219 NORTH to KEYSTONE ROAD; SR#2001. A change of counties occurs -JEFFERSON TO ELK COUNTY. KEYSTONE ROAD is in Horton Township and this is a RIGHT TURN off of SR#219 NORTH.

Race proceeds on KEYSTONE ROAD to RATTLESNAKE ROAD; SR#1008, which is one continuous road. Rattlesnake Road constitutes a change of townships; from HORTON to SNYDER TOWNSHIP. Follow Rattlesnake Road to the intersection of SR#219 SOUTH. A LEFT TURN on to SR#219 SOUTH followed by a QUICK RIGHT turn onto WESTVILLE ROAD; SR#1008. Follow Westville Road to the intersection with BEECHTON ROAD; SR#1011. (A RIGHT TURN onto Beechton Road). TWO TOWNSHIPS are crossed on Westville & Beechton Roads – SNYDER and WASHINGTON TOWNSHIPS. Follow BEECHTON ROAD to the intersection with SR#0028. The townships have changed on Beechton Road back to Snyder Township. CROSS SR#0028 to GAME SCHOOL ROAD; SR#1011. Continue on Game School Road to the intersection with CLAY PLANT ROAD; SR#1010 (A RIGHT TURN). Follow Clay Plant Road to the intersection with NORTH STREET (A RIGHT TURN) and then continue BACK TO THE STARTING/FINISHING LINE in front of Brockway High School.

The **TOUR de BROCKWAY is 21½ MILES** with plenty of signage along the race course. The race course is fully supported by authorized traffic patrol at all crucial intersections and other hazardous locations. The race is for amateur riders (non-professionals) and the Racers must pay an entrance fee to be classified as a **REGISTERED RIDER**. Our Race (Brockway's 4<sup>th</sup>) continues to be one of Central Pennsylvania's premier road races. This race is annually on or around the 4<sup>th</sup> of July in Brockway, PA. The race begins at 11:00 AM on Wednesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Let the fun begin!
